## ***NRA Police Pistol Combat Tournament Announcement***

*Sponsored by the*

### **California Police Pistol Association**

The Riverside Sheriff and the Riverside Sheriff Reserve are conducting NRA Registered Police Pistol Combat Tournaments at the Ben Clark Public Safety Training Center on the same weekend and simultaneously as a “Postal Tournament” at the Sacramento County Sheriff Range.

The Tournaments will be conducted on Saturday May 6<sup>th</sup> and Sunday May 7<sup>th</sup> with the Riverside Sheriff Police Pistol Combat Tournament being fired first. The Riverside Sheriff Reserve Police Pistol Combat Tournament will then be fired. By having back-to-back Tournaments shooters can compete in two Tournaments in one day or fire in one each day.

Each Tournament will be offering the NRA Open Class Semi-Automatic & Revolver Match, Distinguished Semi-Automatic Pistol, Production Pistol & Revolver, Production Semi-Automatic Pistol Matches, Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol & Service Revolver Match and Off-Duty Sidearm Matches. Shooters can also sign up to fire the non-sanctioned **Invitational** California Production Duty Optic Match. Scores from the California Invitational Production Duty Optic Match will be sent to the NRA Law Enforcement Competitions as it is a NRA approved match and has been Sanctioned for this Tournament.

These Tournaments are a great way for you to evaluate your skill level, identify needed training areas, and practice your handgun skills to keep you prepared for the ever-increasing dangers you face on the street and off duty.

### **First Time Shooters**

You do NOT need any fancy gear or guns to start shooting these matches. Just bring your duty handgun, four magazines, holster & magazine pouch. There is nothing to memorize, the course will be announced as you shoot just like the stages during a qualification and fellow officers will gladly help you out. You can even use your stock duty gun to fire the Open Class Division matches to get started and see how challenging and fun these matches are.

**Dates:** Saturday May 6<sup>th</sup> and Sunday May 7<sup>th</sup>

The Riverside Sheriff Police Pistol Combat Tournament will be conducted first each day and the Riverside Sheriff Reserve Police Pistol Combat Tournament will be fired after the first Tournament’s relays have completed.

**Governing Rules:** Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournament. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at [ppc.nra.org](http://ppc.nra.org) or use your smart phone camera to scan this Quick Reader Code or Double Clicking on it.



**Eligibility:** Open to any eligible law enforcement member as outlined in Police Pistol Combat Rule Section 2.4.

**Registration:** Will be done on-site. Please complete the Registration Form at the end of this announcement and bring it with you to speed your registration process.

All competitors MUST present the following items during Registration:

1. Valid Department or Agency Identification
2. Current Classification Card or current Temporary Classification Book unless they have not fired in a PPC Tournament before.

**Riverside Sheriff Reserve Police Pistol Combat Tournament** - Saturday May 6<sup>th</sup> and Sunday May 7<sup>th</sup>

Conducted each day after the above Tournament is completed.

- Fees are the same as above.

**Classification:** Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications and **new shooters** with no Classification or those without a Temporary Record Score



Book will fire in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2. You can check your current NRA Classification at [LEcompetitions.nra.org](http://LEcompetitions.nra.org) or by using your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code to the right or Double Clicking on it.

**Categories:** There will be no categories used in these Tournaments.

**Targets:** Official NRA B-27 targets will be used.

**Scoring:** Competitor scoring will be used. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, **NO** competitor will score their own target **NOR** may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay's makeup contact a Match Official to score the targets. PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors. Scorecards must be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE** double check the recorded hits and values BEFORE signing.

**Course of Fire Information:** Holsters: A conventional right or left-handed exterior belt mounted holster must be used. For safety reasons, shoulder, cross draw, IWB, or holsters which require releasing by insertion of finger within the trigger guard will not be allowed. Holsters cannot be tied down.

**Time Limits:** Time Limits will be announced for each stage or match with complete course instructions. Time will start with loaded gun in the holster. No part of the competitor's hand may touch the gun until the command to commence firing is given.

**Firing Method:** Matches or stages designated as double action must be fired double action. Matches or stages designated as single action may be fired either single or double action. All double action semi-automatic pistols must fire the first shot of every stage double action except at the 50 yard line.

**Loading:** To force reloading under time restraints and magazines are loaded with a maximum of 6 rounds. There is no limit on the number of magazines or speedloaders you have but after initial loading all ammunition used during the firing of a stage or string **MUST** be on your person.

**Optical Devices:** No optical devices, other than normal glasses worn for corrective eyesight purposes or sunglasses are permitted on the range. This includes the use of a mechanical iris, eye patch, or eye cover. Optical, mirror, telescopic, laser beam, electronically projected dots, computerized sighting-aiming devices etc., are prohibited. Binoculars may be used by team coaches as allowed in Section 12.6.

#### APPLIES TO ALL FIREARMS

Rule 3.1

Each competitor is responsible for their firearm and any which may be questionable should be submitted to the Tournament Director, Referee, or 3-Man Jury for decision prior to being used.

All standard safety features of the pistol must operate properly.

With respect to Sections 3.2 through 3.10, and in addition to the firearm specific regulations below, the following features are either Allowed or Prohibited on all firearms.

Ammunition: No high speed or Magnum ammunition will be allowed. Ammunition must be hand loaded or factory loaded to produce sufficient velocity to pass through the target AND the backer. Shots which do not pass through the target and the backer will be scored as misses.

In addition to the specifications within Section 3.1, the following specifications apply for Production Pistols.

Firearm / Caliber: **Approved Pistols for this Division are listed in Police Pistol Combat Bulletin 14.1 on the Law Enforcement Competitions website.** To be considered, must be a mass produced center-fire semi-automatic pistol made for police or military use (at least 1,000 pistols), unmodified stock catalog item in its original factory condition, and have a double, double/single, or striker type action. Must be capable of chambering and firing .35 caliber or larger ammunition, or FN 5.7 x 28 caliber ammunition. All double action semi-automatic pistols must fire the first shot of every stage double action.

Firearm / Caliber: Pistols meeting the specifications for Production Pistols in Section 3.10 and are listed as Approved in Police Pistol Combat Bulletin 14.1 may be equipped with an Approved non-magnified optic suitable for duty use.

**The Duty Optic must be listed as Approved by NRA Law Enforcement Competitions in Police Pistol Combat Bulletin 19.1 on the Law Enforcement Competitions website.**

To be considered for approval, Duty Optics must mount without any modification to the handgun as originally manufactured. Swapping the original slide to an aftermarket slide with optic mount cuts is not allowed since the handgun is no longer as originally manufactured.

The pistol should have co-witnessed front and rear sights, but the rear sight may be removed to mount the Duty Optic or to use a stock Optic Ready Plate.

All Other Specifications are the same as  
Production Pistols

**The NRA has made it clear that NO matter what APPROVED Replacement Sight is used, the sights MUST keep a Duty Gun Point of Aim/Point of Impact, NOT a competition set up, such as a Neck Hold, Shoulder Hold, or Head Hold.**

**A Duty Gun Point of Aim/Point of Impact sight set up requires the sights to be aligned on the X Ring/Center Mass to obtain a Hit in the X Ring/Center Mass area.**

**Pistols with competition sight set ups will be Disqualified, even if having already been used to fire a Match. Competitors may be required to allow their pistol to be test fired, or checked with a laser boresighter to check the sight set up.**
