NRA Police Pistol Combat Tournament Announcement

The Riverside Sheriff and the Riverside Sheriff Reserve are conducting NRA Registered Police Pistol Combat Tournaments at the Ben Clark Public Safety Training Center on the same weekend and simultaneously as a “Postal Tournament” at the Sacramento County Sheriff Range.

The Tournaments will be conducted on Saturday May 1st and Sunday May 2nd with the Riverside Sheriff Police Pistol Combat Tournament being fired first. The Riverside Sheriff Reserve Police Pistol Combat Tournament will then be fired. By having back-to-back Tournaments shooters can compete in two Tournaments in one day or fire in one each day.

Each Tournament will be offering the NRA Open Class Semi-Automatic & Revolver Match, Distinguished Semi-Automatic Pistol, Production Pistol & Revolver, Production Semi-Automatic Pistol Matches, Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol & Service Revolver Match and Off-Duty Sidearm Matches. Shooters can also sign up to fire the non-sanctioned California **Invitational Production Duty Optic Match** and an **Invitational non-sanctioned Duty Rifle Match**. Scores from the Invitational Production Duty Optic Match will be recorded and sent to the NRA for classification (this is a NRA approved match).

These Tournaments are a great way for you to evaluate your skill level, identify needed training areas, and practice your handgun skills to keep you prepared for the ever-increasing dangers you face on the street and off duty.

First Time Shooters

You do NOT need any fancy gear or guns to start shooting these matches. Just bring your duty handgun, four magazines, holster & magazine pouch. There is nothing to memorize, the course will be announced as you shoot just like the stages during a qualification and fellow officers will gladly help you out. You can even use your stock duty gun to fire the Open Class Division matches to get started and see how challenging and fun these matches are.

Dates: Saturday May 1st and Sunday May 2nd . The Riverside Sheriff Police Pistol Combat Tournament will be conducted first each day and the Riverside Sheriff Reserve Police Pistol Combat Tournament will be fired after the first Tournament’s relays have completed.

Governing Rules: Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournaments. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at ppc.nra.org

“The NRA suggested that Match Directors could, at their discretion, use only the NRA National Police Course of Fire (or Matches 5 & 12) for their Tournaments.

The CPPA Board of Directors and Match Hosts discussed the matter and came to the conclusion that for 2021 the registered matches could be the 60 round Match 5 or 12 if that host so desires. The State Championship and the Regional should remain a full 1500 (150 round course of fire) to maintain the integrity of a Championship or Regional. Overall, this should result in a much lower rate of ammo consumption for the shooters as well as making their match day shorter.”

RSO will be shooting the 60rnd matches.

Eligibility: Open to any eligible law enforcement member as outlined in Police Pistol Combat Rule Section 2.4.

Registration: Will be done on-site. Please complete the Registration Form at the end of this announcement and bring it with you to speed your registration process.

All competitors **MUST** present the following items during Registration:

1. Valid Department or Agency Identification
2. Current Classification Card or current Temporary Classification Book unless they have not fired in a PPC Tournament before.

- Fees are the same as above.

Classification: Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications, new shooters with no Classification, or those without a Temporary Record Score Book will be registered in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2.

Competitors may check their current NRA Classification at LEcompetitions.nra.org.

Categories: There will be no categories used in these Tournaments.

Targets: Official NRA B-27 targets will be used.

Scoring: Competitor scoring will be used. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, NO competitor will score their own target NOR may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay's makeup contact a Match Official to score the targets. PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors.

Score cards must be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE** double check the recorded hits and values BEFORE signing.

Courses of Fire: To force reloading under time restraints and magazines are loaded with a maximum of 6 rounds. All times start with loaded gun in holster with hands at sides.

Match 1	Match 8	Two stages of 12 shots each fired double action standing without support. First stage fired at 7 yards and second stage fired at 15 yards. Time limit is 20 seconds per stage including time to reload.
Match 2	Match 9	At 25 yards, 18 rounds fired; 6 shots kneeling; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade, 6 shots standing right handed with support from behind right side of barricade, all fired double action. Time limit 90 seconds, including time to reload.
Match 3	Match 10	At 50 yards, 24 rounds fired; 6 shots sitting; 6 shots prone; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade; 6 shots standing right handed with support from behind right side of barricade. All shots may be fired single or double action. Time limit 2 minutes and 45 seconds including time to reload.
Match 4	Match 11	At 25 yards, 24 rounds fired in two stages of 12 shots each fired double action, standing without support. Time limit 35 seconds for each 12-shot stage including time to reload.
Match 5	Match 12	<p>Stage 1: 7 yards, 12 shots double action standing without support. Time limit 20 seconds including time to reload.</p> <p>Stage 2: 25 yards, 6 shots kneeling; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade, and 6 shots standing right handed with support from behind right side of barricade. All fired double action. Time limit 90 seconds, including time to reload.</p> <p>Change Targets</p> <p>Stage 3: 50 yards, 6 shots sitting; 6 shots prone; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade and 6 shots standing right handed with support from behind right side of barricade. All shots may be fired single or double action. Time limit 2 minutes and 45 seconds including time to reload.</p> <p>Stage 4: 25 yards, 6 shots double action standing without support. Firearms & Ammunition Allowed: Please see NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book Sections 3.1, 3.2, 3.3, 3.6 and 3.7 and the *NRA PPC rule Book Quick View Matrix* reproduced below.

NRA PPC Rule Book Quick View Firearm Matrix

APPLIES TO ALL FIREARMS	Rule 3.1
Each competitor is responsible for their firearm and any which may be questionable should be submitted to the Tournament Director, Referee, or 3-Man Jury for decision prior to being used.	
All standard safety features of the pistol must operate properly.	
With respect to Sections 3.2 through 3.10, and in addition to the firearm specific regulations below, the following features are either Allowed or Prohibited on all firearms.	
Action work to make a crisper and/or smoother trigger pull	Allowed
Fixed or adjustable sights	Allowed
Sight Blackening	Allowed
Modification or change of stocks because of the size of a competitor's hand or to facilitate loading	Allowed
Internal modifications that would render the firearm less safe than originally designed by the manufacturer	Prohibited
Any external modifications, except those allowed within each rule	Prohibited
Front sight extending beyond muzzle	Prohibited
Compensators, barrel venting, or barrel porting	Prohibited
Ammunition: No high speed or Magnum ammunition will be allowed. Ammunition must be hand loaded or factory loaded to produce sufficient velocity to pass through the target AND the backer. Shots which do not pass through the target and the backer will be scored as misses.

In addition to the specifications within Section 3.1, the following specifications apply for Open Class Revolvers.		
Firearm / Caliber: A revolver chambered to fire center-fire cartridges .32 caliber or larger		
Barrel Length Maximum	6 Inches	
Trigger Pull Minimum: Single Action	2.5 Pounds	
Sight Radius Maximum	8.5 Inches	
Sight Guards which do NOT extend rearward more than 2 inches	Allowed	
External Trigger Stops	Allowed	
Grips/Stocks that when measured from side-to-side at the base are greater than 1 ¾ inches in thickness (1.75")	Prohibited	
Caliber / Ammunition: Either hand loaded or factory loaded ammunition may be used. Wadcutter ammunition is allowed.		

OPEN CLASS SEMI-AUTOMATIC PISTOL		Rule 3.3
In addition to the specifications within Section 3.1, the following specifications apply for Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistols.		
Firearm / Caliber: Center-fire pistols of .35 caliber or larger. All double action semi-automatic pistols must fire the first shot of every stage double action except at the 50 yard line.

Trigger Pull Minimum Single or Double Action	3.5 Pounds	
Sight Radius Maximum	8.5 Inches	
Sight Guards which do NOT extend rearward more than 2 inches	Allowed	
Extended Magazine Well Funnel	Allowed	
Magazine Bumper Pad	Allowed	
External Trigger Stops	Allowed	
Caliber / Ammunition: Either hand loaded or factory loaded ammunition may be used. Wadcutter ammunition is allowed
